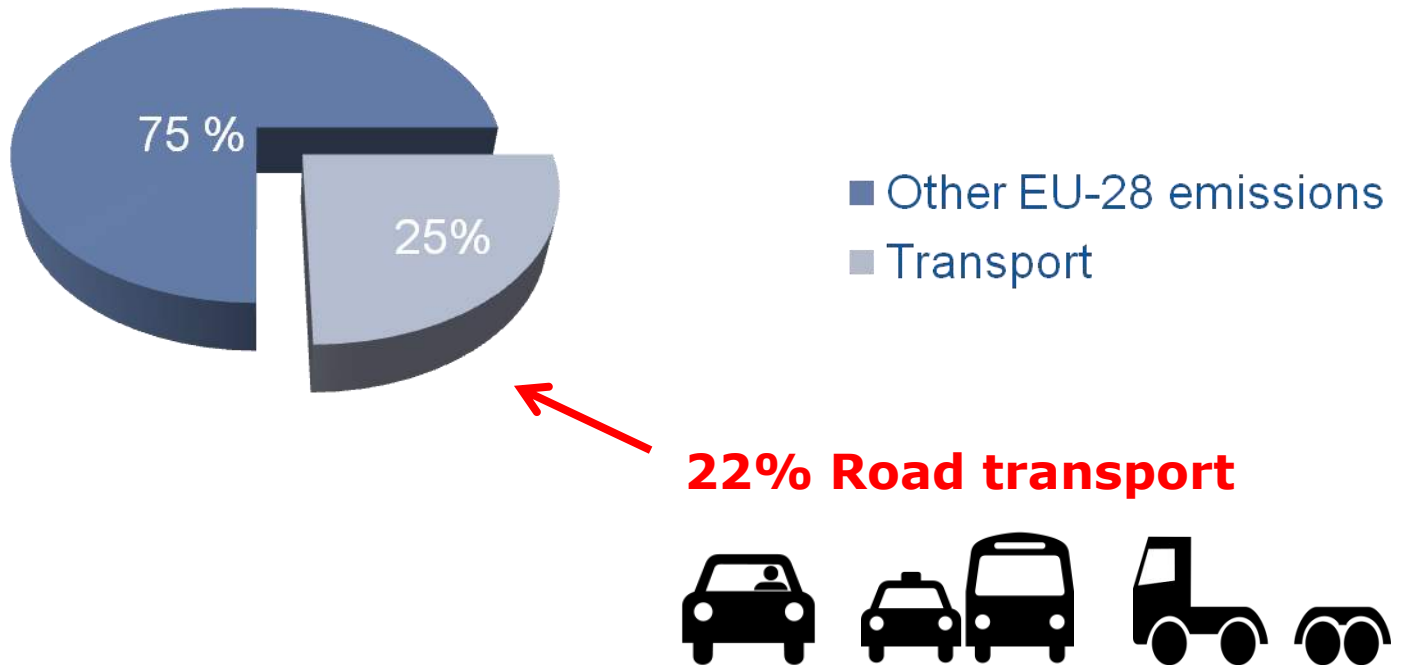

21 Electro mobility



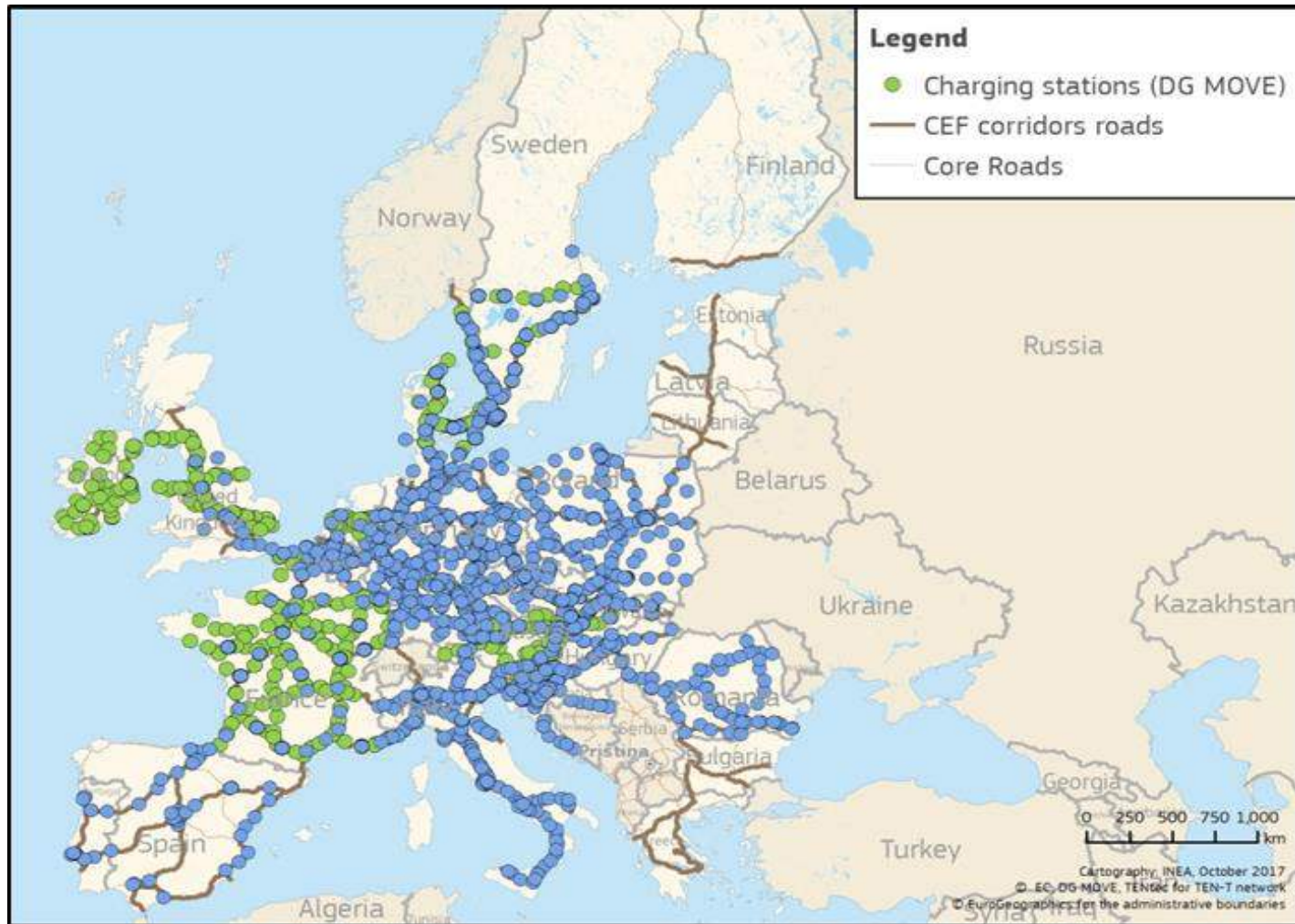
