The choice of mobility based on electric motors for the future is now widely accepted by international analysts, and most car manufacturers are proposing or currently developing electric models and rechargeable hybrids. In Italy, however, the introduction of such vehicles is still slow and strongly depending on the issue of measures supporting the consumer in this choice and also on the development of charging infrastructures necessary for their use.
